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Council Member DeBry, Salt Lake Council Chair, and Commissioner Lee, Utah Commission Chair, co-chaired the meeting.

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Summary of Boundary Adjustment

Mr. Reid Demman, Salt Lake County Surveyor, and **Mr. Gary Ratcliffe**, Utah County Surveyor, explained the change in county boundaries. Changing a boundary requires a public hearing and a joint resolution by the legislative bodies of both counties. The boundary being redrawn is at the top of Traverse Ridge in Draper City. The undeveloped land straddles the boundary between Salt Lake County and Utah County and is owned by two separate

developers. Changing the boundary would allow all of one development to be located within Utah County, and all of the second development to be located within Salt Lake County. With this change, Salt Lake County will pick up a proposed 73 dwellings on 19 acres with a tax value of \$7 million. Utah County will pick up a proposed 25 dwellings on 10.5 acres with a tax value of \$6 million.

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Public Hearing

THIS BEING THE TIME HERETOFORE SET for a public hearing to accept comment on a boundary change between Utah County and Salt Lake County.

Council Member Jensen, seconded by Council Member DeBry, moved to open the public hearing. The motion passed unanimously, showing that all Council Members and Commissioners present voted "Aye."

Ms. Alexandra Eframo spoke in opposition to the boundary change noting she did not see any benefit to the change.

Council Member Jensen, seconded by Council Member DeBry, moved to close the public hearing. The motion passed unanimously, showing that all Council Members and Commissioners present voted "Aye."

A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SALT LAKE COUNTY COUNCIL AND THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF UTAH COUNTY, UTAH TO ADJUST A COMMON BOUNDARY

WHEREAS, Utah Code Annotated § 17-2-209 allows counties sharing a common boundary to make minor adjustments to the boundary;

WHEREAS, Salt Lake County and Utah County desire to make a boundary adjustment as set forth in Exhibit A attached and incorporated by reference to this joint resolution;

WHEREAS, to adjust a boundary the respective legislative bodies of Salt Lake County and Utah County are required to hold a public hearing on the proposed boundary

adjustment, mail written notice to all real property owners of record whose property may change counties as a result of the adjustment, and adopt a joint resolution approved by both county legislative bodies approving the proposed boundary adjustment;

WHEREAS, Salt Lake County and Utah County held a joint public hearing on July 11, 2017, at the Draper City Hall and provided notice to all property owners of record of the proposed boundary adjustment; and

WHEREAS, the proposed boundary adjustment (1) will correspond with the closest existing property boundaries of record and (2) does not divide or split an existing parcel, an interest in property, or a claim of record in the office of recorder of Salt Lake County or Utah County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SALT LAKE COUNTY COUNCIL AND THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF UTAH COUNTY, UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the Salt Lake County Council and Board of County Commissioners of Utah County, Utah have reviewed and hereby approve the boundary adjustment as set forth in the proposed final local entity plat, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference to this Joint Resolution.
- 2. That the Salt Lake County Council and Board of County Commissioners of Utah County, Utah hereby resolve to jointly send to the lieutenant governor within 15 days after the passage of this resolution a copy of an impending boundary action and a copy of an approved final local entity plat.
- 3. That, upon issuance of a certificate of boundary adjustment from the lieutenant governor, the Salt Lake County Council and the Board of County Commissioners of Utah County, Utah hereby resolve to jointly submit to the Salt Lake County Recorder and the Utah County Recorder, respectively, the original notice of an impending boundary action, the original certificate of boundary adjustment, the original approved final local entity plat, and a certified copy of the joint resolution approving the boundary adjustment.
