#### RECITALS

1. Sandy City Corporation (the "City") owns certain real property located within White City Metro Township, more specifically identified as Parcel Nos. 28-08-206-008, 28-08-179-001, 28-08-126-018, 28-08-127-053, 28-08-126-005, 28-08-332-020, 28-08-332-021, and 28-08-355-025 (the "City Property").

2. The County has agreed to construct a trail between 9400 South and Carnation Drive on the City Property to connect trails in this area.

3. To allow for the construction of this trail, the County has requested that the City grant a temporary construction easement on the City Property ("Temporary Construction Easement").

4. The County and the City have negotiated an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement (the "Agreement"), attached as Exhibit 1 hereto, to provide for the construction of the trail and the grant of the Temporary Construction Easement for no fee.

5. It has been determined that the best interests of the County and the general public will be served by executing the Agreement and obtaining the Temporary Construction Easement from the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Salt Lake County Council that the Agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and by this reference made a part of this Resolution, is hereby approved; and the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute said Agreement.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED by the Salt Lake County Council that, upon the County's receipt of the signed the Temporary Construction Easement from the City, the Mayor is hereby authorized to also sign the Temporary Construction Easement, the form of which is attached as Exhibit B to the Agreement.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF SALT LAKE COUNTY, UTAH, AMENDING SECTION 2.97.010 OF THE SALT

LAKE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES, 2001, ENTITLED "DEBT REVIEW COMMITTEE" REDUCING MEMBERSHIP TO SEVEN

The County Legislative Body of Salt Lake County ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. The amendments made herein are designated by underlining the new substituted words. Words being deleted are designated by brackets with a line drawn through said words.

SECTION II. Section 2.97.010, of the Salt Lake County Code of Ordinances, 2001 is hereby amended to read as follows:

#### 2.97.010 - Debt review committee created.

Salt Lake County hereby establishes a [n eight] seven member committee to be known as the Debt Review Committee, which shall review all proposed debt issuance with a repayment schedule that extends beyond the current fiscal year.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after its passage and upon at least one publication in a newspaper published and having general circulation in Salt Lake County.
