The County and the District have entered into a Storm Drain Easement Purchase Agreement. District shall pay the County the sum of Six Thousand One Hundred Dollars for the Easement, which amount has been approved by the Salt Lake County Real Estate Section as fair market value. It has been determined that the best interests of the County and the public will be served by the sale of the Easement to the District.
