Topic/Discussion Title:

A resolution of the County Council of Salt Lake County approving and authorizing execution of subgrant agreement between Salt Lake County and Granton Square, LLC under the Wasatch Brownfields Coalition Revolving Loan Fund Program.

Description: As a member of the Wasatch Brownfields Coalition, Salt Lake County manages a grant from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) from which the County, on behalf of the Coalition, makes low and no-interest loans to eligible recipients to cleanup eligible contaminated brownfields sites. As approved by the EPA RLF Board, the county would like to enter into a 0% interest loan for 3 years with Granton Square LLC in order to facilitate the remediation and redevelopment of a property at 118 West 4800 South in Murray. The loan amount is \$99,403.84, to be repaid over a maximum of three years. All remediation will be overseen by Utah Department of Environmental Quality and the EPA.
