### Topic/Discussion Title:

A resolution of the Salt Lake County Council approving execution of an interlocal cooperation agreement with Bluffdale City providing for the transfer of county transportation funds for certain transportation projects within Salt Lake County.

**Description:** As part of the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter sales tax funding for multi-modal transportation provided by SB 136, the Mayor recommended, and the County Council approved \$2,000,000 in funding for the following project. Bluffdale City Porter Rockwell Boulevard Phase 4 and 5: Completion of Segments 4 and 5 of Porter Rockwell Boulevard; 5 lanes; 10 foot multi-use trail above curb (north west side); 6 foot side walk (south side only); bike lanes; curb gutter; park strip; storm water. Salt Lake County Bikeway Design and Active Transportation Implementation Plan: Bicycle Wayfinding Protocol to be used as reference.
