Salt Lake County desires to use a portion of the City Property to construct, maintain, and operate a household hazardous waste collection facility and related improvements. The parties have negotiated a Ground Lease to permit the County to lease a portion of the City Property for the purpose of constructing, maintaining, and operating the proposed household hazardous waste collection facility, attached hereto as Exhibit A.
